CONVECTION OVEN: Preheat Oven to 350 deg. F. Frozen: Heat for 30-35 min. Refrigerated: Heat for 25-30 mins. CONVENTIONAL OVEN: Preheat Oven to 350 deg. F. Frozen: Heat for 35-40 min. Refrigerated: Heat for 30-35 min. MICROWAVE: Frozen: Heat on High for 2 mins. Let rest for 15 seconds. Heat for another 30-40 seconds. Let rest for 1 min. before consuming.
